SAMOSAS' FILLED WITH SUCCESS

Nayana Ravichandran from Padubidri in Udupi district of Karnataka says receiving the best micro entrepreneur award from Muthoot Microfin last August was one of the best moments of her life so far.

She is now on her 4th cycle loan of ₹ 60,000 and plans to buy an auto rickshaw. Today, Nayana is confident of growing her business further and building a solid future for her children. CHASING INEVITABLE SUCCESS

Housewife turned grocery store owner Jeyamani from Virudhunagar in Tamil Nadu says her business started with Muthoot Microfin loans gave her financial freedom and empowered her to provide for the family.

Until five years ago, Jeyamani's family was struggling to meet both ends. Her husband, a daily labourer was the sole bread winner but without a reliable source of daily income. The family's financial situation was putting a strain on their life.

At that time, Jeyamani decided to find a way to contribute to the household income and started a tiny kiosk adjacent to her home. However, she couldn't fill the racks with enough stocks due to lack of capital. Her business almost failed and once again Jeyamani and her children became reliant on her husband's unpredictable income.

During that time, a Muthoot Microfin Relationship Officer visited her stall and introduced her to the company's services. Soon, she was granted the first cycle loan of ₹ 10,000. Apart from filling her stall with stocks, she saw this as an opportunity to gain better knowledge about running a business.

Gradually, Jeyamani built a loyal customer base for her business and availed second cycle loan of ₹ 40,000. Using the entire amount, she bought more items for the shop. With more items in the store, her business began to grow; her daily income now hit ₹ 500 from a meagre ₹ 100 earlier.
