Muthoot Microfin has received the highest grading in Capacity Assessment and Code of Conduct Assessment by CRISIL. CRISIL's Comprehensive Microfinance Grading of MICI signifies high capacity of the MFI to manage microfinance operations in a sustainable manner and good performance on Code of Conduct dimensions.

The Code of Conduct Assessment of MFI evaluates its adherence to various code of conduct parameters as laid down by regulatory bodies.

The grading is assigned on an eight-point scale with respect to Microfinance Capacity Assessment Grading, 'MI' being the highest grading, and 'M8' the lowest. With respect to the five-point scale for the Code of Conduct Assessment 'C1' signifies the grade for excellent performance on code of conduct dimensions and 'C5' signifies the weakest.

The grading is valid for a period of one year.
