Training sessions are also divided according to school times (One hour in the morning and three hours in the evening). For the first one year, MFA will only concentrate on technical skill development of the students and will not participate in any tournaments. Muthoot Football Academy is all set to produce world class footballers who can compete at the highest levels.
