Shreya Mondal, a 27-year-old Murshidabad, West Bengal resident, has run a grocery shop in Satui village for the past 4 years. Her efforts in running the household along with her husband, Gopal Mondal, couldn't find any progress in the tough and challenging circumstances. She dreamed about expanding her tiny shop with more supplies and space. However, getting financial support without collaterals narrowed her path to obtain financial mobility. Sustainable growth in the household of 5; including 3 children, became a distant dream for Shreya Mondal. That is when she learned about Muthoot Microfin Limited.

Muthoot Microfin offers collateral-free loans to economically active women in rural and semi-urban zones of the nation, with a vision to bring inclusivity and women empowerment. Shreya Mondal applied for the Income Generating Loan under the joint group liability scheme. She used to earn ₹700/- a day before. With timely and affordable support from Muthoot Microfin, she doubled her income. She currently earns ₹1500/- a day and is on the route to financial progress.

Shreya Mondal's story of a strong will to get out of poverty by making the right financial decisions is inspiring when set against the geography she belongs to. Muthoot Microfin's financial literacy training and skill development programs paired with involvement in uplifting the women from the margins, aligns with the noble course of actions visionaries do to build a nation from the grassroots level.

Running a stationary shop, catering to the diverse demands, while ensuring the availability of supplies in the necessary quantity becomes a herculean task when there are financial constraints. Parbati Goud, a 54-year-old women entrepreneur from Jurkabhata village in Kalahandi, Odisha runs a small stationary shop. She has been running the business with the support of her husband Baikuntha Goud for the past 26 years. The interpersonal relationships she kept and her expertise in the field attracted the crowd to her shop, however, expanding business supplies became a necessity. That's when she approached Muthoot Microfin Limited and learned about the potential that was residing with the opportunities it offered.
