



DETAILS OF THE CSR PROJECTS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF MUTHOOT MICROFIN LIMITED FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2024-25

Company's CSR initiatives are mainly implemented/ channelised through Muthoot Pappachan Foundation (MPF), a Public Charitable Trust formed in the year 2003 as the CSR arm of Muthoot Pappachan Group (MPG) to facilitate CSR activities for the entire Group and all its business verticals.

The CSR initiatives of MPG revolve around the theme HEEL covering Health, Education, Environment and Livelihood.

Details of CSR project approved for the FY 25 is;

PROMOTING HEALTH CARE ***(SCHEDULE VII (i) Promoting health care including preventive health)***

SMILE PLEASE (Cleft Surgery Mission)

The CSR Programme 'Smile Please' free surgery mission for cleft patients. So far Mission Smile has conducted 25000+ surgeries in India and all of them were safe and successful. From July 2014 MPF joined the hands with Mission Smile and started to provide free cleft surgeries and allied supportive service to children with congenital cleft issues.

BLUE BUTTERFILES (Paediatric Cancer – Treatment & Nutrition Support)

Blue Butterflies is a pan-Kerala project by Butterfly Cancer Care Foundation in collaboration with MFL, Special attention will be given to patients from backward districts like Palakkad, Idukki, Malappuram, and Kasaragod. This project focuses on providing quality "Treatment Preparedness Support" to paediatric cancer patients from financially poor families.

Partnering with Muthoot has been a boon for Butterfly Cancer Care Foundation as this CSR initiative has been able to take off in the best possible way. The project theme has been "Treatment Preparedness Support" with a view to protecting and treating cancer affected children and youngsters. The high-quality paediatric cancer treatment care has been offered to patients from backward districts like Palakkad, Idukki, Malappuram, and Kasaragod.

Through this project, 360 kids who are suffering with cancer were supported for the last three years and nutrition support was extended to 120 kids is active throughout Kerala State and will take in children who need treatment as per the prerequisites of the institution.

MPCES Sports Infrastructure Construction (Palakkad) (“Sports Academy”)

The vision of the Sports academy is to create a world class institution by leveraging the academic and sports eco system, attracting the best talents – both faculty and students and helping them build successful careers in sports.

It is a complete Sports Facility Infrastructure i.e, Blue Muthoot Sports Hub at Vadakarapathi village in district of Kerala.

It is proposed to build an exclusive world class training facility which will be the first of its kind in India. The Sports Academy project is coming up on a 16-acre plot of land in Palakkad.

The Sports Hub comes up with a FIFA standard Football stadium with a pavilion facility to occupy 1200 audience and a residential facility to run the Football Academy.

MUTHOOT FOOTBALL ACADEMY

Muthoot Football Academy is an initiative of Muthoot Pappachan Foundation, to create a positive learning environment in which players are encouraged to express themselves and play freely without fear, and to nurture young players so that they can achieve their full potential.

The professionally run academy has a curriculum prepared by international coaches that provides the best available coaching and training in the world. The unique coaching program provides an accent of high – quality education apart from training, good nutrition, health care, life skills and training for career in sports.

MUTHOOT VOLLEYBALL ACADEMY

The Muthoot Volleyball Academy is to nurture the sport of Volleyball at the grassroots level in Kerala and help it scale new heights. It is not just a coaching initiative; it is a wholehearted service to the sport that is Volleyball. Volleyball is a popular sport in the rural areas of Kerala and that is why our aim is to help these underprivileged kids to excel in this sport by imparting quality training to develop their skills so that they can compete successfully in District, State, National and International Championships. Muthoot Volleyball Academy helps volleyball to grow, develop, and become more popular from the ground up, The Muthoot Volleyball Academy aims to create residential academies, expand all volleyball centres throughout various

districts of Kerala, facilitate roof courts, and hold district- and state-level inter-centre championships.

ENVIRONMENT

RAJASTHAN – ACCESS TO WATER PROJECT PARTNERSHIP WITH RRF
