Muthoot Microfin Wins SKOCH Award





Muthoot Microfin Limited has been honoured with two SKOCH Awards for its contributions to digital financial inclusion and insurance programs. The company won Gold in the "Best Customer Application on Digital Financial Inclusion" category for its Mahila Mitra initiative (1.73 million downloads, 4.2-star average rating), and another Gold for "Best Insurance Scheme" for its NatCat Insurance Scheme (2.66 million insured beneficiaries). The awards, which recognise entities driving positive socio-economic change, were conferred upon Muthoot Microfin on January 15, 2025, at Silver Oak Hall, India Habitat Centre, Lodhi Road, New Delhi, after a rigorous five-round selection process that included public opinion.

NatCat Insurance Scheme is a specialised natural calamity insurance product for Muthoot Microfin Limited's existing customers. With faster claim settlement within O-7 days from the date of submission of documents, "Griha Suraksha" offers affordable insurance coverage to underserved communities. The NatCat Insurance Scheme, offering coverage of up to 1,00,000/– for home, 20,000/– for contents, 1,00,000/– for personal accidents, and protection of 3 EMIs in case of unforeseen circumstances, is priced at just 420/– for 3 years. This makes it one of the most accessible insurance options for communities previously excluded from such facilities due to financial constraints. Muthoot Microfin also drives financial inclusion through digital transformation, focusing on accessibility and security. The "Mahila Mitra" app, with vernacular support and integrated payment gateways, facilitates paperless transactions and efficient loan processing. Future goals include expanding payment options, enhancing user experience, and integrating financial literacy resources, aiming for 100% digital adoption and empowering customers to manage their finances effectively.

These achievements, validated through a rigorous selection process, solidify Muthoot Microfin's position as a leader in leveraging technology and innovative solutions to empower individuals and foster inclusive growth.
